

Softball Player Checklist:

What do I need to start playing at Sports Park?

1. **JOINING A ROSTER:** A team. If you would like to play you will need to put in an entire team, register as a free agent, or if a team captain has asked you to join their team you will need to register a team player for that team.
2. **ROSTERS:** Everyone on a team will need to follow step one to make sure you are added to the roster properly. Rosters will freeze 2 weeks after the first day of league play.
3. **TEAM FEES:** ALL team fees will need to be made in full 24 hours before game time to be added to the schedule.
4. **UNIFORMS:** Uniforms are NOT required but sure are fun. You can have uniforms if you would like but please keep it respectful. No anti anything, racial, etc.
5. **EQUIPMENT:** Players will need to bring in their own bats, balls and masks. If you're wearing cleats please note that metal cleats are NOT allowed. '

-Bats: Bats will need to include one of the following stamps:



No senior bats and no shaved bats will be allowed.

-Softballs: Men's Softballs will need to be Men's Classic M 12' 40 Core 325 Compression.

Coed/Women's softballs will need to be a Women's Classic W 11'. You can bring your own softballs as long there are no obvious tears and as long the ball is visible at night. There will be softballs available in the office for purchase also.

-Masks: This doesn't mean helmet. The mask can come with a helmet, but you must have a metal or shock resistant plastic facemask. Here is a sample mask from Amazon "RIP-IT Defense Softball Fielder's Mask":
