Sports Park Rules

- **There is a \$2 admission fee** for all players & guests entering the park over the age of 12. Family, friends & the general public are encouraged & invited to attend and support all participants. There are NO refunds or credits given, even if the games end up being cancelled due to weather conditions.
- **Outside food & drinks are NOT allowed.** There are a few exempt items like Water, Gatorade, Fruit, Nuts and a Cup of Coffee. You can even bring in coolers with the exempt items. Additional food & drinks are available for purchase at the concession stands.
- **Backpacks, gym bags & purses are subject to search.** No weapons or alcohol are allowed.
- **Sports Park Tucson promotes good sportsmanship,** fair play, kindness & respect towards all staff members, team players, and their guests. Unsportsmanlike conduct or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated and will lead to ejection from the park.

Expectations

- **Team Captains are responsible for the payment of all team fees.** You can easily make your payment through the Sports Park Tucson website sportsparktucson.com.
- **Waivers** are located on the website & must be completed no later than the second week of play. Players not present the first week of play will still be required to read & /acknowledge the team member waiver before participating in any games. Insurance coverage is the responsibility of each participant.
- **Sport rules for the regular season & tournament play as well as general rules can be found our website at sportsparktucson.com.** Please make yourself familiar with them. Team Captains are responsible for letting their team members know about the rules. You can either make your own copies for your team members, or refer them to the SportsParkTucson website so they can read the rules online.
- **For Softball:** You can bring your own **softballs** so long they are CLASSIC M for men and CLASSIC W for women's. Please be sure the balls you bring do not have cuts, rips, and is safe to see at night. Balls will also be available for purchase at the front office. Umpires will be inspecting all equipment including softballs and bats so please be prepared for that. Softball bats will need to have one of the following stamps:



Pitching masks are required of all pitchers. Umpires will hold the final scores of all games.

- **For Beach/Sand Volleyball: ALL SPORTS PARK TUCSON VOLLEYBALL GAMES ARE SELF- OFFICIATED.** This is an honor system that has been in place at Sports Park Tucson from the beginning. Players make their own calls. Team Captains are encouraged to enforce fair play rulings. If there is a questionable call or play, or teams disagree over a call, an automatic replay will be instated. Since Sports Park Tucson volleyball games are self-officiated, teams are not required to send participating team members as referees or line judges for any games, but are responsible for keeping their own game scores.
- **Team Captains are responsible for their teams conduct.** Sports Park Tucson is a place where everyone wants to come to have fun and find friendly competition. It is the Team Captain's job to encourage fair play & help resolve disputes calmly.
- **Be on time!** Game time is forfeit time ☹ Advise your team members to arrive 15-20 minutes early to stretch & warm up before your game.
- **Please call ahead** 520-333-5862 in the event that your team has to forfeit. We are sometimes able to rearrange games so your opponents aren't left hanging. There is a \$20 forfeit fee that will need to be paid before your next scheduled game. Make sure to add subs to your rosters to avoid forfeits! Rosters WILL be frozen on the second week of league play so please keep that in mind.
- **Team shirts** or numbered shirts are not required, but sure are a lot of fun!
- **Incomplete Games:** Sometimes the weather could interrupt a game midway through. For Volleyball: Any set that has one team score more than 15 points will be counted as final. Any set that does not have either team at 15 points could be replayed in full.
- No refunds will be given as the result of circumstances beyond our control.
